I understand the referees are here to provide a service, and I pledge not to contribute to the astounding numbers of referees walking away from youth sports due to this behavior
* I pledge to AVOID inflicting damage to my high five hand by banging on the glass before, during, or after the game. SUPPORTIVE CHEERING ONLY .
* I pledge to AVOID forgetting that things happen in sports. I will always remember the message from my children that says. I'm just a KID, it's just a GAME, the officials are only HUMAN, and NO college scholarships will be handed out today
